- Individuals fluent in non-official languages in Switzerland (Polish, Portuguese, Pashtu, Dari, Farsi, Spanish, etc.)
- As an independent member of the team we will help you establish yourself as an independent practitioner (not employee status) within a collaborative work environment.
- Available workdays are Tuesday and/or Wednesday and/or Friday and/or Saturday.

Our horizontal structure furnishes a platform to approach our patients' treatment in a multi-faceted, collaborative fashion. Under the clinical supervision of Dr. Lauren Deimling Johns, we aim to build off of the impressions and assertions of our team members in a collective approach to the care of our clientele. This structure also encompasses collaboration with our Director of Communication and Design, Syl Hillier, on administrative strategies regarding patient communication, marketing, design and invoicing.

Our growth will allow us to more effectively serve our local expat and immigrant communities, and reach further outward in this era of extensive isolation.
